A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT, BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE MILLAGE FOR THE 2025 TAX ROLL; LEVYING A TAX ON ALL PROPERTIES, REAL AND PERSONAL, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE POMPANO BEACH EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT, FOR OPERATION AND/OR MAINTENANCE EXPENSES OF POMPANO BEACH EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT USING A TENTATIVE MILLAGE OF 0.5000; PROVIDING THAT THE TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE REPRESENTS A 7.99% INCREASE IN PROPERTY TAXES WHEN COMPARED TO THE ROLLED-BACK RATE OF 0.4630; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the sum of \$11,546,198 for operation and/or maintenance expenses for October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2026, fiscal year must be raised by a tax levy on all non-exempt real and personal property within the limits of the Pompano Beach Emergency Medical Services District; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Broward County Property Appraiser that the assessed valuation of taxable property on the 2025 Tax Roll, after certain exemptions have been allowed, in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, amounts to the sum of \$23,092,396,581 for operation and/or maintenance expenses; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF POMPANO BEACH EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT, POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the Board of Commissioners of the City of Pompano Beach Emergency Medical Services District adopts a tentative levy of 0.5000 mills on the total non-exempt valuation of \$23,092,396,581, and the receipts from said levy are to be deposited in the Pompano Beach Emergency Medical Services District Fund to be used for the operation and/or maintenance expenses of the Pompano Beach Emergency Medical Services District for October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2026, fiscal year.

SECTION 2. That the Board of Commissioners hereby finds and determines that such tentative levy of 0.5000 for operation and/or maintenance expenses represents a 7.99% increase in property taxes. This increase in property taxes is due to the increase in the City's assessed valuation of taxable property on the 2025 Tax Roll.

SECTION 3. That a public hearing to adopt a final millage rate and budget shall be held in accordance with Section 200.065, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall become effective upon passage.
