Film Permitting Process Guide

The City of Pompano Beach supports film and media production and offers a no-cost film permit. All productions must provide detailed information to ensure proper coordination and tracking.

Primary Intake – Film Lauderdale

All permits are initiated through Film Lauderdale, Broward County's Office of Film & Entertainment. They coordinate applications and track productions countywide.

Application Requirements

- Production company contact information
- Type of production and filming dates (including rain dates)
- Exact locations
- Number of cast, crew, and vehicles
- Special needs (traffic, police, etc.)
- Insurance listing City as additionally insured

City Review Process

Permits are reviewed and routed to City departments, BSO, and Commission. Standard review time is one business day.

Approval

If approved, permits are signed, finalized, and returned to Film Lauderdale. Conditions may apply based on project scope.
