PROJECT OBJECTIVES

Replace 38-year old fire station located at NW 3rd Avenue south of Copans Road with a new fire station to reduce response time and enhance fire and emergency services to the area which will include a new 2-story, multi-bay building.

PROJECT UPDATES

- The general contractor and sub-contractors continued working onsite
- The sub-contractor continued installing LVT flooring, decorative wall panels and molding around the edges on the 2nd floor of the building dining officer quarters and main hallway
- . The sub-contractor completed installation of the security cameras in the apparatus bay and around the building
- The drainage crew connected the sewer main lines from the building to the lift station on the N.E corner
- . The city utility crew completed the installation of the backflow meter, valve and 2-inch potable backflow preventer
- . The window crew started installing the exterior window awning on the building
- The sub-contractor fabricated and installed the exhaust for the backup generator and vented outside the housing
- The contractor completed the east driveway rock base, the paving contractor paved the east driveway
- FPL has connected the main power supply to the fire station and tested the backup generator, transformer and approved
 of the connection
