PROJECT OBJECTIVES

Enhance public safety on the beach by replacing four (4) older, outdated lifeguard towers and modernizing the existing Ocean Rescue Building. An additional four (4) lifeguard towers were commissioned to be constructed at the same time utilizing CIP funding. Expansion of building to include a second floor. The second floor addition will support the existing Ocean Rescue services and enable the facility to increase useability to include a large meeting/training room.

- The general contractor and crews completed the upper tie-beams and porch floor form and steel works
- Continued installing braces
- Contractor scheduled concrete but delivery time may be an issue
