PROJECT OBJECTIVES

Enhance public safety on the beach by replacing four (4) older, outdated lifeguard towers and modernizing the existing Ocean Rescue Building. An additional four (4) lifeguard towers were commissioned to be constructed at the same time utilizing CIP funding.

PROJECT UPDATES

Assembly of stations 1 and 6 is still in progress. All 8 stations are expected to be ready and operational by the end of the year. The team met with FDEP to discuss the addition of a second floor to the existing structure. A set of plans was submitted for inital review and FDEP conceptually approved the second floor expansion. Team to prepare for DRC and City will work with design team on a change order.


