NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the City Commission Meeting on July 10, 2018 at 6:00 p.m., the City Commission approved the FY 2018-2019 Proposed Annual Action Plan funding below. The City of Pompano Beach is a HUD entitlement community. As such, we receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME grant funding that we allocate to local non-profit organizations and City departments that administer public service, housing, public facilities, economic development and infrastructure for our residents. This year, the City's allocation is **\$1,038,308.00** for CDBG and **\$453,745.00** for HOME, 2016-2017 & 2017-2018 CHDO Reprogram Reserve in the amount of **\$93,027.60**, totaling **\$1,585,080.60**.
