Notice is hereby given that the City of Pompano Beach will conduct a virtual public hearing on Monday, March 1, 2021 at 4:00 PM in order to submit under the State Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) relief program. Due to the ongoing COVID-19 emergency the public hearing will be held virtually via Zoom. The Zoom invitation link and passcode to attend the public hearing is listed above.

CDBG-CV Entitlement and Small Cities program funds will be awarded following a pre-application and final application process for eligible activities approved by DEO. Funding for the CDBG-CV Entitlement program will be awarded up to the amount of the entitlement community's allocation.

Eligible activities under the CDBG-CV program include acquisition of public property for public works facilities and sites; public improvements; business and microenterprise assistance; public services; project planning and administration; and broadband planning and public infrastructure.

Eligible activities under the CDBG program must meet one of the three national objectives listed in federal statutes: benefit low – moderate income households or persons; elimination of slums and blight; or meeting urgent community development need (with prior department approval).

The City of Pompano Beach anticipates submitting an application under the CDBG-CV relief program in an amount not to exceed \$518,651 under the NOFA for the following eligible activities (activity amounts include activity delivery and Admin):

Public Services: Emergency Rental Assistance- \$518,651

The purpose of this public hearing is to give the public an opportunity to make their comments known on the proposed activities/application.
