



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Preservation and Reinvestment Initiative for Community Enhancement (PRICE) Grant Application

The City of Pompano Beach Office of Housing and Urban Improvement will conduct a public hearing to gain input regarding the submission of the Preservation and reinvestment Initiative for Community Enhancement (PRICE) grant application.

HUD issued a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) which appropriates **\$225 million** in competitive grant funding for the preservation and revitalization of manufactured housing and eligible manufactured housing communities. Congress has directed HUD to undertake a competition using the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) statutory and regulatory framework for this first-of-its-kind initiative. The Preservation and Reinvestment Initiative for Community Enhancement supports communities in their efforts to maintain, protect, and stabilize manufactured housing and manufactured housing communities (MHCs).

The sole purpose of this meeting will be to promote opportunities for residents, public agencies, and other interested parties to examine the plan's contents and submit comments. Comments received during the public hearing will be incorporated into the City's final grant application package. The PRICE application is published in its entirety on the City's website for public comment as well.
