Activities funded by CDBG or HOME programs must contribute to the goals and objectives of the City of Pompano Beach Consolidated Plan and meet all applicable federal requirements. The program awards grants in order to carry out a wide range of community development activities directed toward revitalizing neighborhoods, economic development, and providing improved community facilities and services. The CDBG program is an important tool in helping local governments tackle the most serious challenges facing their communities. CDBG funds may be used for activities that include, but are not limited to: **Acquisition of Real Property; Relocation and Demolition; Rehabilitation of Residential and Non-Residential Structures; Construction of Public Facilities and Improvements, such as Water and Sewer Facilities or Streets; Neighborhood Centers, and the Conversion of Schools for Eligible Purposes; Public Services (within certain limits); Economic Development.**
