Born in Caracas, Venezuela, **Alejandra Abad** is an interdisciplinary visual artist and educator who explores belonging and mutual compassion as key parts of collective wellness. Through layering, abstraction, and light, she creates new landscapes that relate to place, family, and community. Her playful storytelling often features fragmentation,

folklore, and mythology. Abad's installation work creates environments that include sculptural elements and video projection that relate the history of anticolonial movements to international surrealism and magical realism.

Abad's art features conceptual and collaborative pieces that work to break down the barriers between artist and audience. Her style is informed by architectural studies at Florida Atlantic University, Film/Video/New Media/Animation at The School of the Art Institute of Chicago, and Interdisciplinary Media Art Practices at The University of Colorado. This has led to a series of works centered on environmental futures and the implications of the Anthropocene.

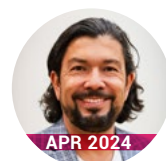

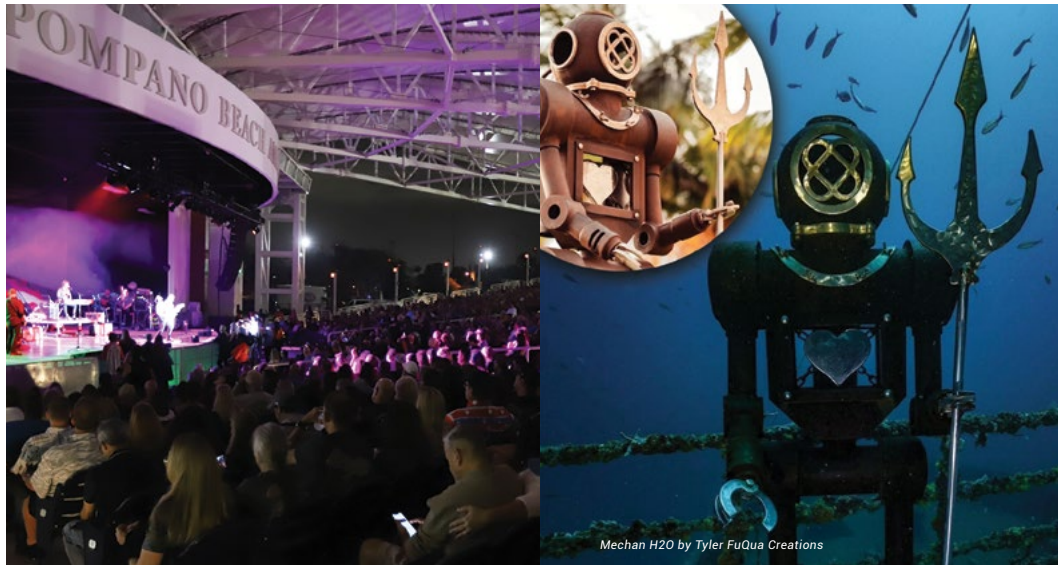

## POMPANO BEACH PUBLIC ART PROGRAM

Public art is a powerful tool used to enhance our City, educate, and inspire! Since the Public Art Committee's inception in 2012, Pompano Beach has commissioned sculptures, murals, wrapped traffic boxes, and, most recently, we sank a massive sculpture to join for the City's permanent underwater exhibition.

Entitled "Mechan H2O", by Tyler FuQua Creations, this 700-pound steel creation depicts a robot scuba diver! For a year, it was on display at the beach, becoming an Instagram-worthy shot that delighted residents and tourists alike. The long-term plan, however, was for Mechan H2O to reside under the sea. In July 2023, the artwork was submerged and attached to the "Lady Luck" in Shipwreck Park, an underwater cultural arts park, featuring unique sculptures and other existing wrecks covered with marine life.

"Lady Luck", a 324-foot tanker vessel, was sunk in 2016 as an artificial reef 1.5 miles off Pompano Beach's shore, and is the centerpiece of Shipwreck Park, one of the most easily accessible major dive sites in the nation.
