Rounding out the month is a stunning three-day series at the Pompano Beach Cultural Center—Jazz Reflections, Ladies of Simone, and *Exquisite* – a premiere celebration of Black artistry, culinary excellence, and cultural expression. Together, these events showcase a breadth of talent and uplift the legacy of Black creatives in South Florida and beyond.

I would be remiss not to spotlight the remarkable work of the Pompano Players, whose offerings this quarter include three standout productions—*Beehive*, *First Date*, and *BOCA*. Their commitment to high-quality theater continues to set a benchmark for local performing arts.

There truly is something for everyone in Pompano Beach. Enjoy the season—and the very best time of the year to be in Florida.
