SUBJECT: **Upcoming OpenGov Sourcing Module Go-live (October 1st, 2026)**

Dear Valued Vendors and Suppliers,

The City of Pompano Beach, FL is excited to announce the upcoming transition to a new web-based Sourcing platform, **on October 1st, 2026**, in partnership with OpenGov.

Our new eProcurement portal will allow prospective Vendors the ability to:

- Register to receive notifications of future bidding opportunities.
- Follow along with updates to existing opportunities, and receive amendments and addenda automatically.
- Submit questions and receive answers online for active solicitations.
- Use a guided process of responding electronically to bids to ensure your bids have been accurately completed.
- Enhance the process for proposals evaluation and award.

⇒ After the transition to the new system is completed, and OpenGov goes live **on October 1st, 2026**, all vendors **must** be registered with OpenGov to participate in any new solicitation advertised by the City of Pompano Beach.

⇒ There is no cost for vendors to register in OpenGov.

For vendors currently registered with the City of Pompano Beach in the current eBid system (IonWave), an email was sent by OpenGov last year to activate and update your account. If you did not receive the email or if you are a new vendor that want to register and receive automated notifications and participate in upcoming solicitations, please register at our new eProcurement Portal by clicking the **+Subscribe** button in the below link.

Category Codes

The City of Pompano Beach, FL will be using the **NIGP category code set**. Please review this [article](#) on setting up category codes and notification preferences in OpenGov.

Important:

Current eBid system (IonWave) sunset: Following the go-live of OpenGov on October 1st, 2026, the City of Pompano Beach will no longer use IonWave to advertise new solicitations; however, current solicitations advertised prior to October 1st, 2026, in IonWave, will be managed and awarded in IonWave.

IonWave is scheduled to be decommissioned towards the end of 2026 to allow any solicitations advertised before October 1st, 2026 to be processed.
