

Pompano Beach has partnered with several other Broward County cities to provide the collection and disposal of household hazardous waste (HHW) and electronic scrap recycling. The collection of materials takes place 13 times annually at drop off locations throughout the county. With proof of residency, Pompano Beach residents have the ability to go to other participating cities for their collection events. There is no cost to residents of Pompano Beach for this service. This program is for residents only; businesses must arrange for eco-friendly disposal of hazardous waste by a licensed hazardous waste hauler.

- Set aside your hazardous waste and electronic recycling items. DO NOT put hazardous waste in your regular garbage container or with your bulk waste.
- Bring your items to a scheduled collection event.
- Be prepared to show proof of residency. A driver's license showing your current address is preferred.
- Collection events are held rain or shine. However, it is always best to check with the city hosting the collection event to verify dates and times.
