

## Hurricane Preparedness

Prior to the storm's arrival, safely secure your garbage and recycling carts inside your garage or residence. Garbage and recycling service may be suspended during this time. After the storm, separate vegetative waste (trees and shrubs) from other bulky items and garbage. Normal garbage and recycling collection service will resume as soon as roads are accessible.

## Holiday Schedule

Thanksgiving Day (third Thursday in November) and Christmas Day (December 25th) are the only days that waste services are suspended. If your service day falls on either or both of those days, your garbage and/or recycling will be collected on the next regularly scheduled collection day. If you are an absentee owner, please forward this information on to your tenants.

To accommodate the additional amount of garbage and recycling generated during the holidays, extra material will be accepted during the week of December 26th through January 1st. Extra material must be bagged/tied and placed next to the full carts.

## Illegal Dumping

Illegal dumping is a crime. In fact, it is a FELONY. Please report anyone illegally dumping by calling Broward Sheriff's Office at 954-764-4357.

## Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Items such as rechargeable batteries, house paints, fertilizer, computers, televisions, tires, and other household hazardous wastes (HHW) cannot be collected curbside. The City of Pompano Beach has joined with other surrounding cities to provide hazardous materials collection events. These events are held during the year at various locations provide proper disposal for hazardous items. There is no cost to Pompano Beach residents. Proof of residency is required. ## Lost or Stolen Cart

If your gray or blue cart is stolen, please contact the Broward Sheriff's Office. The B.S.O. non-emergency hotline is 954-764-4357. Once a report has been made, you can call Environmental Services at 954-786-4030 with the case number, and arrangements will be made to deliver a new cart to your home.

If you need an additional cart, you may purchase one for \$50. Call 954-786-4030 to arrange for payment and delivery.



## Garbage Carts

**Garbage is collected twice a week.**



ALL garbage, including vegetative materials and yard trash (palm fronds, coconuts, grass clippings, twigs, etc.) must be placed inside the cart with the lid closed. Only vegetative material and yard trash that is too large to fit in your cart should be set out for bulk removal.

Roll your cart to the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day. The cart handle must face away from the street, with the lid opening facing the roadway. Return your cart to its storage area that same day.

- Please bag all garbage to keep carts clean and odor-free.
- Only City-provided carts will be collected. Resident-owned cans or containers WILL NOT be serviced.
- Any material left outside of the cart or placed on top of the cart WILL NOT be collected.



## Recycling Carts

**Recycling is collected once a week.**

Pompano Beach offers its residents "single-stream" recycling. This means all recyclable material can be placed in the cart together.

ALL recyclable material must be placed in your cart loosely, not bagged. Acceptable recyclable materials include: aluminum and tin cans; glass bottles and jars; plastic bottles; magazines; newspapers; and flattened cardboard.

Roll your cart to the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day. Cart handles must face away from the street, with the lid opening facing the roadway. Return your cart to its storage area that same day.

## Bulk Waste Collection Guide and Drop-Off Location

Curbside collection is provided at single family homes once a week. Multi-family properties and condominiums receive collection by appointment only; check with your property management for information.

### Curbside Collection Guidelines

- Residents are limited to placing four cubic yards of material curbside each week.\*
- Any vegetative material placed curbside must be prepared and bundled, with branches and limbs not exceeding six (6) feet in length and five (5) inches in diameter. Each stump may not exceed 50 pounds.
- Only material generated from the location will be removed. It is unlawful to bring materials from another location and place out for collection.
- Materials do not include household hazardous waste, special wastes, construction and demolition waste, vehicle parts, tires, electronics, or products containing glass which can break during collection.
- Bulk waste items must be in such a size and/or quantity that does not allow for the materials to be placed into the gray garbage cart for normal garbage service.
- Materials for removal should be placed off the roadway, on the front swale.
- Place items away from power lines, fire hydrants, trees, fences, vehicles, or any other objects that would impede collection of the material.
- Do not place materials out for removal earlier than 5:00 p.m. prior to your collection day.
- Residents are allowed two additional bulk collections (up to 16 cubic yards) per calendar year as a courtesy. These collections **must be scheduled prior to** setting out the bulk waste at the curbside. Call Environmental Services at 954-786-4030 to schedule your pickup appointment. **Demolition and construction debris is strictly excluded.**

### Bulk & Recyclables Drop-Off Location

Extra bulk waste and acceptable recyclables can be dropped off on Saturdays between 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. at 1840 NW 33rd Street, Pompano Beach. This is available to all Pompano Beach residents; proof of residency is required. Materials will be accepted at the residential drop off station only from residential customers in non-commercial cars, pickup trucks, or trailers (with a bed no larger than four (4) feet by eight (8) feet.

## Collection Map and Schedule

Please be aware this map was updated on October 1, 2022 and your collection days may have changed. Refer to the map and chart below to determine your collection days.

Garbage and vegetative yard waste is collected twice per week in the gray garbage cart. Recycling is collected once per week in the blue recycling cart. Bulk waste is collected once per week at your curbside. See bulk collection guidelines (left) for more details.

### Collection Map

**To determine your collection days:**

1. Locate your address on the map to the left.
2. Identify the color for your service area.
3. Match the color from the map with the corresponding color on the Collection Schedule Chart below.

### Acceptable Bulk & Recyclable Items

- Household Goods – Appliances, furniture, mattresses, large toys, draperies and other miscellaneous household materials.
- Horticulture – Yard trimmings which will not fit in the gray cart for normal garbage service.
- Building Materials – Wooden fence sections six (6) feet or less in height and length, wooden doors, sinks, toilets, and materials generated from minor building repairs (not to exceed 1/2 cubic yard).
- Recyclables – ONLY approved recyclable items as listed on Environmental Services web page at [PompanoBeach.gov](http://PompanoBeach.gov) or Coastal's web site [Coastalwasteinc.com](http://Coastalwasteinc.com) will be accepted.

**\*A cubic yard is three feet wide by three feet high by three feet deep.**

### Guidelines for Setting Out Your Carts

Follow these rules to ensure your garbage and recycling is collected on time and without difficulty.

- Set carts out before 7:00 a.m. on collection day or after 5:00 p.m. the day before collection.
- Remove carts from the curb on the day of collection.
- Set carts at least three (3) feet apart with lids closed and facing toward the street.
- Set carts at least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes, etc.
- All materials must be placed inside the carts. Any material outside of the carts or on top of the carts will not be collected.
- Garbage should be bagged to help keep carts clean and odor-free.
- Do not put recycling materials in plastic bags. Make sure the loose materials are clean and dry before adding them to your blue cart.
- Full carts cannot weigh over 150 pounds.
