If approved, the Charter Amendment shall be as follows (additions are indicated by <u>underline</u>; deletions by <u>strikeout</u>), and shall take effect thirty (30) days after the election in which they were adopted:

#### ARTICLE II: THE COMMISSION

#### Sec. 6. OFFICE OF COMMISSIONER AND MAYOR-AT-LARGE.

The City Commission shall consist of a number of electors of the City corresponding to the number of districts established (1)pursuant to Article I, Section 3, of this Charter, one (1) Commissioner to be elected from each of said districts by vote of only the electors within that district, and a Mayor elected by vote of all electors within the City. In accordance with the laws governing municipal elections in Broward County, future elections shall be transitioned to be held on the first Tuesday in November March of even number years. during general elections. For the municipal general election of March 2012, November 2018 the terms of office of City Commissioners who were elected from odd numbered districts (1) one, (4) four and (5) five shall expire when successors are sworn in but not later than one week after the municipal general election in November March of 2014 2022, and for the municipal general election of March 2013 November 2018, the terms of office of City Commissioners who were elected from even numbered districts (2) two and (3) three shall expire when successors are sworn in but not later than one week after the municipal general election in November March of 2014 2020. Successor Commissioners shall be elected for terms to fill seats for terms of two four years or until their successors are elected and qualified to fill seats as terms expire in the respective districts. Also, for the municipal general election of March 2013, Tthe term of office of the Mayor shall expire when a successor is sworn in but not later than one week after the municipal general election in November of 2016 March 2020. Successor Mayors shall be elected for terms of four (4) years or until their successors are elected and qualified.

TERM LIMITS:

No person who has served terms totaling eight years as Mayor shall be qualified for further election to that office, (a)

No person who has served terms totaling eight years as a Commissioner shall be qualified for further election to that office, (b) The above sections shall not prevent a person who is disqualified from serving as Mayor by length of service from serving (c) as a Commissioner or a person who is disqualified from serving as a Commissioner, by length of service, from serving as Mayor providing there is a break in service between the office of Mayor and Commissioner or Commissioner and Mayor of at least one municipal general election,

Any Commissioner or Mayor whose years of service exceed the above limits while in elected office as of the date of (d) adoption of this Charter Amendment may continue elected service until a successor is sworn in following the next

municipal general election without violation hereof.

The term limits established by this measure may only be changed or amended by a majority vote of the citizens of Pompano Beach, Florida. (e)

Sec. 9. MAYOR AS PRESIDING OFFICER; SELECTION OF VICE-MAYOR BY CITY COMMISSION; VACANCIES.

At the first meeting after the regular annual municipal general election, the Mayor and City Commissioners shall elect by ballot a Vice-Mayor from their group by the majority vote of not less than three (3) members. In case of a tie vote in election of the Vice-Mayor, the City Commissioners shall continue to ballot; but if the tie persists after four (4) ballots, the names of those persons nominated shall be written on appropriate slips of paper by the City Clerk and the Clerk shall place them in a box with several similar slips of paper bearing no names. The City Clerk shall proceed to draw a slip of paper from the box until such time as the City Clerk draws the name of one of the nominees. The City Clerk shall then cast a vote for the person whose name has been drawn. If a vacancy occurs in the office of Vice-Mayor, it shall be filled by the City Commissioners in the same manner. If a vacancy occurs in the office of Mayor, and at the time the vacancy occurs there are six (6) months or more remaining until the next municipal general election, a special election shall be called to fill the vacancy which shall be within ninety (90) days from the date of the vacancy, and candidates to fill the office must qualify with the City Clerk as provided by ordinance but not less than three (3) weeks prior to the special election. The Mayor shall preside at City Commission meetings a citizen elected Mayor shall be authorized to vote only should a City Commission vote be tied with an equal number of affirming and opposing Commissioner votes -shall vote and in all other respects have the duties, privileges, and responsibilities of a Commissioner, and shall be recognized as head of the City Government for all ceremonial purposes and by the governor for the purposes of military law, and shall execute all instruments to which the city is a party when directed to do so by the City Commission, unless otherwise provided by this Charter or by ordinance, but the Mayor shall have no regular administrative duties. The Vice-Mayor shall act as Mayor in the absence or disability of the Mayor, failure of the Mayor to continue in office or vacancy in the Office of Mayor, except when filled as provided hereinabove, but shall not automatically become Mayor if the office of Mayor shall become vacant.

Sec. 18 (RESERVED) POLITICAL ACTIVITY IN BEHALF OF A CANDIDATE FOR NON-PARTISAN OFFICE. No political party or partisan political organization shall endorse, support, or assist any candidate in a campaign for election to a City non-partisan office.

(1) Any person who knowingly, in an individual capacity or as an officer of an organization, violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable for each and every violation or offense as provided in FRS. 775.082 or FRS. 775.083.
