Book Swim Test Appointment:

Participants must pass a swim test in order to participate in the Pompano Beach Jr. Lifeguard Program. Participants from the 2019 & 2020 Pompano Beach Jr. Lifeguard Program are exempt from this requirement.

Parents can register their child for a "Swim Test Appointment" on the Aquatic Center's reservation system. You will select "Sign Up" and complete a profile. After completing the profile go to the "Programs" tab and select "Jr Lifeguard Swim Test". Then click on "Book This Jr. Lifeguard Beach Swim Test" and continue with prompts to select a date/time. Once completed correctly the system with automatically issue you a confirmation of your appointment. We can test up to three (3) children per appointment if they live in the same household. The single appointment only needs to be under the Parent's profile.

Day of Appointment:

Arrive at least five (5) minutes to check in with the front desk. Children need to come to the appointment in their swim suits and ready to get in the water. Parents will remain outside the facility & may choose to watch the swim test from the outside of the perimeter fence. Masks are required in and around the facility. Children can remove their masks before entering the water and must put it back on once they complete their swim test.

Program Registration:

The lifeguard will give the "passed" evaluation form to the Cashier and the parent may then complete the registration with the cashier. If the child does not pass the swim test they cannot register for the program. Swim test appointment does not guarantee availability for program registration. Registration remains on a first come first served basis for availability.

CITY OF POMPANO BEACH SUMMER CAMP 2021 INFORMATION SHEET



The City of Pompano Beach Parks & Recreation Department would like to thank you for your interest in our **Junior Lifeguard Beach Camp**. With the ongoing pandemic, the health and safety of our campers and staff remain our highest priority. Below, you will find a summary of actions we are taking to help ensure we are lowering the COVID-19 risk as much as possible.

- Camp will be limited to twenty (20) participants per session. Each session will be broken down into two (2) groups of ten (10) participants, one (1) Coordinator, & one (1) Rec Aide. The Head Coach will oversee both groups and fill in for lower positions as needed.
- To minimize the mixing of campers, registration will be taken by session only.
 Registration deadline for each session will be at 12PM on the Friday <u>before</u> the next session starts.
 - Session 1: June 14 2021 to June 25, 2021 (Deadline of June 11 @ 12PM)
 - Session 2: July 5, 2021 to July 16, 2021 (Deadline of July 2 @ 12PM)
 - Session 3: July 26, 2021 to August 6, 2021 (Deadline of July 23 @ 12PM)
- Camp registration will open on May 5th at 12PM. Participants from Jr. Lifeguard Camp 2019 & 2020 will not have to re-take a swim tests. New participants will sign up for a swim test appointment (Instructions on page labeled "Book Swim Test Appointment").
- All staff members and campers will be required to wear a mask with the exception of eating or while engaged in strenuous activities.
- Campers and staff will be subject to a temperature check and health screening each morning prior to entering camp.
- Campers or staff with a temperature of 100.4 degrees and/or exhibiting signs of COVID-19 will be sent home immediately and will not be allowed to return without a doctor's note.
- If a child develops symptoms while at camp, they will be isolated and their parent/guardian will be contacted to pick them up.
- Games, activities, and field trips will be structured with social distancing guidelines in mind.
- Equipment (rescue cans, paddle boards, etc.) will regularly sanitized between users.
- To reduce the number of communal items campers will have a list of supplies that they
 will need to bring to camp daily. These items cannot be shared by campers or staff. (See
 Supply List)
- Staff will have campers hand sanitize after each activity and will have them wash their hands often. Campers will be expected to practice proper hand-washing techniques.
- Field trip waivers/forms will be distributed on the first day of camp session and must be returned to the Head Coach two days before appointed field trip. Failure to turn in fieldtrip form will result in the child not being allowed to attend camp on day of appointed trip & camp fees will not be prorated to reflect lost day.





Supply List:

Please send your child to camp each day with the following:

- Uniform Rash Guard Shirt & a swim suit.
- · A snack & plenty of water
- Sunscreen labeled with your child's name (Staff will not apply sunscreen to campers)
- Mask or Buff style face covering for group activities.
- Additional equipment may be needed per activity week (Snorkel equipment, fishing rod, etc)

Operational Hours and Sign IN/OUT procedures:

Jr. Lifeguard Camp hours are Monday to Friday from 8:30AM to 12:30 PM. When dropping off your child it is mandatory that a parent or authorized adult walk them into camp and sign them in on a daily attendance sheet. Campers will be subject to a temperate check & heath screening prior to entering camp. Please make sure all individuals authorized to pick up your child are listed on their registration form. These individuals must show ID before child will be released to them.

We ask that you help us continue to protect the health of our campers and staff this summer. Anyone who is not feeling well or exhibiting signs of illness- including staff, campers, and families- should not come to camp. Be on the lookout for symptoms of COVID-19, which include fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, and loss of taste or smell. - 12. Use program equipment and supplies in a safe and respectful manner.
