Beach parking lots will remain open until capacity is reached. The pier parking garage will be charging a flat \$20.00 fee to park there. Pay by the hour for the other lots, and street parking is also available. Pier Street will be closed both Saturday and Sunday. Food is permitted on the beach. Alcohol is prohibited outside of designated festival areas and VIP area, and glass bottles are prohibited on the beach.

Feel free to enjoy the beach, museums, shops, Fishing Village restaurants, and the visitor's center. The pier will be closed. The local talent stage will begin approximately at 1:00pm. Food and beverage vendors will open at 3:00pm. DJ Music will begin shortly after.

Can I bring my pet?

Pets are not allowed on the beach.
