CITY ORDINANCES

§ 98.92 CULTURAL FACILITY FEES

(I) Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is only allowed in conjunction with an approved facility rental located within any indoor approved cultural facility. An additional application is required for requested distribution and consumption of alcoholic beverages for any such rental and is subject to approval by the city's law enforcement agency upon an applicant meeting all additional requirements for service of alcoholic beverages at its cultural facility. Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be served for consumption on the immediate premises.

§ 110.02 UNLAWFUL SALES.

- (A) No person shall give, sell, deliver, serve, or permit to be served any alcoholic beverages to the following.
 - (1) Any person under the age of majority, actually or apparently.
 - (2) To any person who is intoxicated.
- (3) To any patient under the supervision or control of any state hospital, whether the patient is on furlough or otherwise.
- (4) Any person who is a habitual drunkard and known to be such by the person selling, delivering, serving or permitting to be served any alcoholic beverage, after notification by the Police Department.
 - (5) Any person brought before the court charged with nonsupport of wife, family, or other dependent.
